



STUDENT ENROLMENT POLICY

Introduction

St Joseph's is committed to an open enrolment policy that is consistent with our Statement of Philosophy and all applicable State and Commonwealth Laws, including anti-discrimination, equal opportunity, privacy and immunisation legislation.

Our enrolment policy is also consistent with the diocesan enrolment policy.

Enrolment Criteria

We accept enrolments on the basis of:

- academic ability
- interests and extracurricular achievements
- date of application
- family or other association.

Student Intakes

St Joseph's enrolls students in years Foundation to 6.

Enrolments outside of these intakes will be considered on an individual basis.

Applications

All applications for enrolment at the School must be completed in accordance with the Student Enrolment Form.

Consideration

Enrolments are considered by the Principal each year. The Principal will consider each application and make a determination based on the enrolment criteria.

Anti-Discrimination

St Joseph's is committed to the principles of our anti-discrimination obligations. We will consider all enrolments in accordance with our Disability Discrimination Policy and our duty to make reasonable adjustments but reserve the right to depart from that policy where it is legally permitted and in accordance with our Statement of Philosophy.
